- After your selection has been made, press the RED CAST VOTE BUTTON located in the lower right corner. This electronically records your vote.
- Part the curtains and exit the voting booth.

#### BOND PROPOSAL

The Board of Education of the Lower Cape May Regional School District in the County of Cape May, New Jersey is authorized: (a) to undertake various improvements and renovations to the Teitelman Middle School and the Lower Cape May Regional High School and to construct a new field house; (b) to acquire the necessary furnishings and equipment and undertake any associated site work; (c) to appropriate \$6,367,963 for such improvements; (d) to issue bonds of the School District in the principal amount of \$6,367,963; and (e) to transfer funds between the school facilities projects.

The final eligible costs of the improvements approved by the Commissioner of Education are \$3,555,463, consisting of \$1,569,938 for the Teitelman Middle School and \$1,985,525 for the Lower Cape May Regional High School. The proposed improvements include \$2,812,500 for the new field house for school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service due on the improvements' final eligible costs.

#### BOND PROPOSAL

The Board of Education of the Township of Lower in the County of Cape May, New Jersey is authorized: (a) to undertake various improvements and renovations to the Maud Abrams Elementary School, the Carl T. Mitnick Elementary School and the Charles Sandman Elementary School; (b) to acquire the necessary furnishings and equipment and undertake any associated site work; (c) to appropriate \$5,121,473 for such improvements; (d) to issue bonds of the School District in the principal amount of \$5,121,473; and (e) to transfer funds between the school facilities projects.

The final eligible costs of the improvements approved by the Commissioner of Education are \$5,121,473. The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service required to finance the final eligible costs of the projects. The proposed improvements do not include school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g).

A "yes" vote would authorize the Board of Education of the Township of Lower to appropriate funds and issue bonds for the projects listed above.
