- 1** To vote on the PUBLIC QUESTION press the button to the right of the word "YES" or "NO"; a green "X" will appear next to your selection.
- 2** To change a selection, press the button again. The green "X" will disappear and you may make a new selection.
- 3** After your selection has been made, press the RED CAST VOTE BUTTON located in the lower right corner. This electronically records your vote.
- 4** Part the curtains and exit the voting booth.

PUBLIC QUESTION

Shall the "Bond Ordinance Providing for the Improvement of Pacific Avenue in and by the Borough of Wildwood Crest, in the County of Cape May, New Jersey, appropriating \$2,700,000 therefor and authorizing the issuance of \$2,571,000 Bonds or Notes of the Borough for Financing such Appropriation," finally adopted on October 7, 2015, be ratified?

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

A "YES" vote to ratify this Ordinance would provide the funding to complete the Pacific Avenue Street Improvements, including additional landscaping, grass and concrete medians, appropriating \$2,700,000 therefor and authorizing the issuance of \$2,571,000 Bonds or Notes of the Borough for Financing such Appropriation.

A "NO" vote would defeat the Bond Ordinance in entirety and require the introduction of a new ordinance for Pacific Avenue Improvements.
