| <p align="center"><u>BOND PROPOSAL NO. 1</u></p> <p>The Board of Education of the Township of Middle in the County of Cape May, New Jersey is authorized: (a) to undertake improvements, renovations, and additions/new construction to Elementary School #1 and Elementary School #2, as well as improvements and renovations to the Middle School and High School; (b) to acquire the necessary furnishings and equipment and undertake any associated site work; (c) to appropriate \$21,320,439 for such improvements; and (d) to issue bonds of the School District in the principal amount of \$21,320,439. The Board of Education is also authorized to transfer funds between the projects approved at this special election.</p> <p>The final eligible costs of the improvements approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education are \$5,708,114, consisting of \$2,747,160 for Elementary School #1, \$1,472,476 for Elementary School #2, \$753,050 for Middle School, and \$735,428 for High School. The proposed improvements include \$9,584,225 for school construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g), consisting of \$3,061,500 for Elementary School #1, \$6,510,725 for Elementary School #2, and \$12,000 for the Middle School. The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service required to finance the final eligible costs of the projects.</p> | |

| <p align="center"><u>BOND PROPOSAL NO. 2</u></p> <p align="center">(Bond Proposal No. 2 will only go into effect if Bond Proposal No. 1 is also approved by the voters.)</p> <p>The Board of Education of the Township of Middle in the County of Cape May, New Jersey is authorized: (a) to provide for the construction and the refurbishment of athletic and playground facilities at Elementary School #2, including the acquisition and installation of playground equipment, athletic fields, concession stand, and storage facility; (b) to acquire the necessary furnishings and equipment and undertake any associated site work; (c) to appropriate \$3,324,699 for such improvements; and (d) to issue bonds of the School District in the principal amount of \$3,324,699. The Board of Education is also authorized to transfer funds between the two bond proposals.</p> <p>The proposed improvements include \$3,324,699 for school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g).</p> | |

| <p align="center"><u>INTERPRETIVE STATEMENT</u></p> <p>If both <i>Bond Proposals</i> are approved, the total cost of the improvements will be \$24,645,138 and will be financed with School District bonds in the amount of \$24,645,138. The final eligible costs of the improvements approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education for both <i>Bond Proposals</i> are \$5,708,114, consisting of \$2,747,160 for Elementary School #1, \$1,472,476 for Elementary School #2, \$753,050 for Middle School and \$735,428 for High School. The proposed improvements include \$12,908,924 for school construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g), consisting of \$3,061,500 for Elementary School #1, \$9,835,424 for Elementary School #2 and \$12,000 for Middle School. The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects.</p> | |
