EMERGENCY TIME: If a voter’s application did not meet the “Last Day to Receive” deadline, the voter must appear in person or by authorized messenger at the County Clerk’s Office during Emergency Time to receive a ballot.

If the voter is using a messenger, the voter must complete an application, including the name of the messenger, then sign section #8 and #11 and give the application to the messenger to bring to the County Clerk’s Office. The messenger must present his/her photo identification along with the application. Upon approval the ballot will be given to the messenger for delivery to the voter.

MESSENGER: A messenger must be either a family member or a registered voter of this County and cannot be a candidate in the election for which the voter is requesting the ballot. No person shall serve as an authorized messenger for more than three qualified voters in an election.
