In 2019, a significant change was made to the New Jersey vote-by-mail process. Voters who requested and received a Mail-in Ballot for the 2016, 2017, and 2018 General Elections automatically receive mail-in ballots for all future elections.

If you do not want to vote by mail in all future elections, you must advise the County Clerk in writing that you want to “opt-out” of voting by mail. If you prefer to cast your vote at an early voting site (October 23-31) or at your polling place on Election Day, please sign and date the form below and return it to the County Clerk’s Office.

Please be advised that if you do not notify our office in writing that you wish to opt-out of voting by mail, you will only be permitted to vote by mail or vote provisionally at the polls in all future elections.
