



## THREE WAYS TO VOTE IN NEW JERSEY!!

There are now **THREE** ways to cast your vote in NJ.

1. **Vote-By-Mail:** Starting 55 days before each election (April for the June Primary and September for the November General) you may apply to receive your ballot in the mail. You may choose to receive it for one election only or for all elections moving forward. You then vote and return the ballot to the Board of Elections via postage-paid mail, drop box or in person. If you are an "all election" VBM voter you can opt out at any time by sending in an opt-out form. If you are an "all election" VBM voter you may not take advantage of voting the next two ways. If you appear at the early voting site or polling place on election day you will vote a provisional ballot.
2. **\*New\* Early Voting:** There will be three regional early voting centers set up throughout Cape May County. Starting on Saturday, October 23rd and ending on Sunday, October 31st you may go to **ANY** of the three sites and vote your specific ballot on a voting machine. We will be using brand new electronic poll books to streamline the process. Don't forget to bring your sample ballot with you as this will greatly speed up the check-in process! The hours are Monday - Friday and Saturday(s) 8am - 8pm, and Sunday 10am - 6pm.
3. Traditional voting at your polling place on election day, November 2nd. This option is the same as it has always been where you go to your municipal polling place on election day between the hours of 6am and 8pm.
