PUBLIC QUESTION TO BE VOTED UPON

PROPOSAL

The Board of Education of the Township of Lower, in the County of Cape May, New Jersey ("School District"), is authorized to: (a) undertake for lawful school purposes a capital improvement program consisting of: (i) improvements to the HVAC and electrical systems at the Memorial School, together with the completion of various other improvements, including building interior renovations and roof replacement; (ii) improvements to the HVAC and electrical systems at the Carl Mitnick School, together with the completion of various other improvements, including building interior and exterior renovations; (iii) improvements to the HVAC and electrical systems at the Maud Abrams School, together with the completion of various other improvements, including building interior renovations; and (iv) improvements to the HVAC and electrical systems at the Sandman School, together with the completion of various other improvements, including building interior renovations; (b) expend for all the foregoing an amount not to exceed \$20,668,192, of which: (i) \$15,625,984 represents eligible costs ("Eligible Costs"), as determined by the Commissioner of Education; and (ii) \$2,833,768 represents Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief ("ESSER") funds received by the School District pursuant to the Coronavirus Aid Relief and Economic Security Act, to pay for a portion of the HVAC improvements described above; and (c) issue bonds of the School District for said project in an amount not to exceed \$15,625,984, in which event the State will pay approximately 40% of the debt service (principal and interest) of the school bonds issued to finance the Eligible Costs; (d) utilize \$2,208,440 from the School District's capital reserve account to fund a portion of the project costs; and (e) transfer unexpended bond proceeds between said school facility projects. This school facilities project includes \$0 for school facility construction elements in addition to the facility efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or that are not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g).

INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING

- Please read through the instructions completely. After inserting the card given to you by the poll worker, insert it into the card slot in the device to the right, cut corner of the card in the upper right.
- Touch **YES** or **NO** on the **PROPOSAL** to make your selection. Your selection will turn **Green**. To Change your selection, touch the **Green Box** again and it will de-select your choice. You may make a new selection.
- When you have completed voting and verified your selection, touch the **Green "Print Ballot"** button on the lower right side of the screen. A confirmation message will first be displayed to "**Return to Ballot**" or "**Print**".
 - To make any changes before printing the voter paper audit trail, touch "**Return to Ballot**".
 - To proceed with printing the voter paper audit trail, touch "**Print**".
 - This will print your selection on the card and display it in the printer window for your review.
 - Review the card to ensure it represents your selection accurately. Then touch the "**Cast**" button only if what is displayed on the card accurately reflects your choice.
 - If changes need to be made after printing the Voter Paper Audit Trail, touch the "**Quit**" button to cancel the voting session. A poll worker will be signaled to assist you. You must return your spoiled paper audit trail folded to the poll worker in order to receive a new activation card to start the voting process over.
